



## Feeding and nesting stations for wildlife



### Description

In addition to the varied and diverse habitats created in the garden for plants, there are numerous opportunities for fauna. These can be enhanced by the inclusion of service stations throughout the design and might include:

- bat boxes
- bird boxes (various birds)
- feeding tables and hangers
- hedgehog nests
- slowworm nests
- lacewing nests
- butterfly feeding stations etc.
